Major Developments

Update: Over 845,000 Customers Remain Without Power across New England and Canada after Windy Winter Storm

A winter storm moved across swaths of New England and Canada causing significant snowfall accumulations and treacherous conditions. Hardest hit were New Hampshire, Maine and New York where conditions have slowed restoration efforts with some utilities expecting customers to be without power through the weekend. Neighboring utilities have been brought in to assist crews to restore customers. Public Service of New Hampshire reported the highest utility outages with over half of its service territory without power.

Strong Winds Batter Virginia, Maryland Area Leaving over 33,000 Customers in Region without Power February 26

Throughout the Virginia, Maryland and DC region February 26, high winds ranging between 50 - 55 mph have impacted the area causing over 33,000 customers to lose power. At the height of the outages, 12,931 Dominion customers were without power in Virginia, 13,811 Baltimore Gas and Electric customers were without power in Maryland, Allegheny Power reported 4,179 customers out in Maryland and PEPCO reported 2,317 customers out in D.C. and Maryland the morning of February 26.

In a bulletin to shippers, Teppco Partners reported its fuel terminal in Shreveport, Louisiana will run out of ultra low sulfur diesel fuel at noon February 28 due to high demand with the outage expected to last until early morning March 2.

Canadian Oil Sands Producers Benefit from Gas Surplus, Low Prices in Expanding Oil-Sands Operations in Canada

Numerous companies operating oil-sands production sites in Canada are benefitting from a natural gas surplus into the country along with lower than normal prices of natural gas. Specifically, Syncrude, the world's largest oil-sands operator, said the situation will increase output by 50 percent. Another company, Canadian Oil Sands announced plans February 25 to boost bitumen production to 600,000 b/d with projects scheduled to get underway during the next 4 years.

The U.S. Coast Guard restricted vessel traffic in the Atchafalaya Channel in southern Louisiana after a ship struck a Contango Oil & Gas Company natural gas line causing a fire and minor injures. Traffic along the Channel will be cleared every four hours the Coast Guard reported, whereas Contango declared force majeure on February 24 due to curtailed production of the affected platform and transporting pipeline. EPA Emissions Regulations may Delay BP's Refinery and Natural Gas Projects, Company Lobbyist Worries

A corporate lobbyist for BP warned that the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) recently announced plans to regulate greenhouse gas emissions will lead to delays in the permitting process for new refinery and natural gas projects across the U.S. The company said it fears that the new federal rules will leave state regulators short-handed and unprepared to handle the large amounts of permitting applications required under the rule, especially in the early years of the new greenhouse gas program.
