Update: Fewer than 30,000 Customers Remain Without Power across Northeast United States after Windy Winter Storm February 24 – March 2

Just over 12,000 customers in New Hampshire, fewer than 12,000 customers in New York, about 1,900 customers in Maine, and scattered customers elsewhere remained without power on March 2, days after winter storms cut electricity to more than 1 million, multiple sources reported. Update: Dominion's 871 MW Millstone Nuke Unit 2 in Connecticut Ramped Up to 98 Percent by March 2

Operators shut the unit due to the "loss of two circulating water pumps" on February 26, the company said in a filing with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). The NRC reported that on the morning of March 1 the unit was operating at 60 percent.

Officials Eye 2013 Start-Date for 268 MW Compressed Air-Based Power Plant in Iowa

The "Iowa Stored Energy Park" would store compressed air underground, and then release the air to power two 134 MW generators, according to a news source and the project's website. Officials began drilling a test well by March 2, and the project is slated to enter service in three years. It has received funding from the U.S. Department of Energy, and the Iowa Power Fund. Multiple utilities are expected to provide financing.

Included in PG&E's spending plans are upgrades to its electric and natural gas systems, adding smart meters, and a 500 MW solar panel program, a news source said. The company also aims to purchase an Iberdrola-owned, 246 MW wind farm. Some of the projects are contingent on regulatory approvals.

Citgo Slows Rates after Unit Shutdown at 167,000 b/d Lemont, Illinois Refinery by March 2

Unspecified problems forced shut a crude unit late last week, forcing Citgo to reduce rates at its 167,000 b/d Lemont, Illinois refinery, trade sources said on March 2. Pending repairs, the unit should resume service by the end of this week.

Alaskan oil production averaged 681,041 b/d in February 2010, compared to 750,034 b/d in February 2009, according to a report from the Alaska Tax Division. The figure, however, was down only slightly—511 b/d—from January 2010.

Earthquake Forces Shut Chilean Refineries, Halts Loading at Quintero LNG Terminal

Chile's ENAP shut its 116,000 b/d Bio Bio refinery and its approximately-100,000 b/d Aconcagua refinery after the weekend earthquake, the state-owned company said by March 1. ENAP expected to restart the Aconcagua facility next week, it said on March 2. The company said it had enough gasoline to provide for two weeks of demand, and enough diesel to account for 10 days. Despite that, it planned to import more diesel. Separately, the earthquake damaged the loading arm at BG's Quintero LNG terminal; the company said it was not accepting vessels, and did not have a timetable for restoration.

Update: CIG to Complete Repairs at 115 MMcf/d Los Cabin Compressor Station in Wyoming by March 4

Colorado Interstate Gas (CIG) declared force majeure at the facility on December 19, 2009, citing a coolant leak and extensive damage, according to a previous filing. The incident slowed the site's capacity by 25 MMcf/d, to a total 90 MMcf/d. El Paso Opens 945 MMcf/d, approximately 190-mile Elba Express Natural Gas Pipeline, Completes Expansion of Elba Island LNG Terminal in Georgia by March 2

El Paso Corporation's subsidiary, Southern LNG, Inc., opened three new vaporizer units at its Elba Island LNG receiving terminal near Savannah, Georgia, boosting the site's send-out capacity to 1.75 Bcf/d on March 1, El Paso said in a release. Separately, Elba Express Company, L.L.C, another El Paso subsidiary, opened the 945 MMcf/d, approximately 190-mile Elba Express Pipeline by March 2. That line delivers natural gas from the Elba Island LNG terminal to customers in the southeastern and eastern United States.
