The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, Regulation and Enforcement (BOEMRE) yesterday approved its fifth deepwater drilling permit since the Deepwater Horizon disaster, authorizing Chevron USA Inc. to drill at Well #1 in Keathley Canyon Block 736, approximately 216 miles off the Louisiana coastline. # Update: Libya War to Blame as OPEC Crude Oil Shipments Slated to Slide by More than 400,000 b/d in Four Weeks to April 9, Compared to Prior Four Weeks: Oil Movements

The Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries (OPEC) will ship 23.03 million b/d in the four weeks ending April 9, compared to 23.46 million b/d in the four weeks to March 12, Oil Movements said on March 24. Oil Movements blamed the expected decline on the war in Libya. It said, however, that producers in the Middle East would boost shipments by 1.5 percent – to 17.72 million b/d – over the four weeks to April 9 in an attempt to compensate for Libya's lost output. ## Unrest Forces Offline 50,000-70,000 b/d Oil Pipeline and at Least 6,600 boe/d of Oil-and-Gas Production in Yemen by March 24

A tribal attack forced offline a 50,000-70,000 b/d oil pipeline by March 23 and a recent assault on Yemen's primary oil export pipeline led Austria-based OMV AG to halt 6,600 boe/d of oil-and-gas production, news and company sources reported. A Yemeni official, however, said the shutdown of the 50,000-70,000 b/d pipeline would not impact the nation's oil exports. Yemen typically produces 260,000 b/d of oil.

## Update: Japanese Official Warns of Possible Crack, Radiation Leak from Reactor No. 3 at Tokyo Electric Power's Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant in Japan March 25

The reactor core at reactor No. 3 of Tokyo Electric Power's earthquake-and-tsunami-damaged Fukushima Daiichi nuclear power plant in Japan might have cracked and leaked radioactive materials, Bloomberg News reported, citing a spokesman with the Japan Nuclear and Industrial Safety Agency said. Workers were unable to restart the cooling systems at reactors No. 1, 3, and 4 or the control room at reactor No. 2 of the facility, but the company did begin injecting freshwater into at least two reactors' pressure vessels by March 25, company, news and official sources reported.
