Storms, Heavy Winds Cut Power to 77,542 Customers in Missouri and Kansas May 2

Winds gusted close to 85 mph, downing trees and power lines, and wrecking at least 200 homes and businesses. In Missouri, the storms cut power to 40,000 Kansas City Power & Light customers, 13,322 Aquila customers, 3,260 Ameren customers, and 5,000 Independence P&L customers. In Kansas, some 15,960 Westar customers lost power. By 9 AM this morning, KCP&L restored service to about half its downed customers. Rebels Attack Oil Pipeline in Colombia, Shutting 93,000 b/d Throughput April 29

Rebels bombed and halted the 225,000 b/d Cano Limon-Covenas oil pipeline Tuesday night, Colombia's state oil company said May 2. The pipeline remains shut, as of the report. Though the pipeline can move up to 225,000 b/d of oil, it was transporting about 93,000 b/d at the time of the attack. The pipeline stretches from Colombia's Arauca province to the Caribbean coast.

Update: BP Breaks Ground on Expansion at 410,000 b/d Whiting, Indiana Refinery as Indiana Regulators Issue Air Permit – Still Awaiting EPA Approval

The Indiana Department of Environmental Management issued BP an air permit for its proposed expansion of the 410,000 b/d Whiting, Indiana refinery. BP, in turn, began preliminary construction work on the upgrade. The project, however, still requires EPA approval, and faces opposition from environmentalists, who may appeal the state's ruling. The upgrade will boost Pascagoula's gasoline production by about 10 percent, or around 14,000 b/d. It will not expand the refinery's crude oil capacity.
