# **Update: BP Reroutes Crude Oil from Leaking, Larger Pipe at Blown-Out Oil Well in Gulf of Mexico**

BP was successfully able to reroute some oil through a siphon system over the weekend. A tube was inserted into a leaking riser that connected Transocean's Deepwater Horizon rig with an underwater well before the April 20 explosion. The initial attempt to put the tube in place was unsuccessful, but a second attempt on May 15 proved successful. According to BP senior executive vice president Kent Wells, BP is slowly increasing the rate of oil recovery from the leak. Engineers are working on a system to stop the flow of oil, which is expected to be ready by the end of next week. BP and government officials are estimating about 5,000 b/d of crude oil is leaking into the Gulf of Mexico.
