Strong Storms Knock Out Power to 110,000 Xcel Customers in Minnesota June 14, Nearly all Restored by June 16

Strong storms with frequent lightning and heavy rain knocked out power to 110,000 Xcel Energy Customers across the Twin Cities and southeastern Minnesota on Saturday. Winds knocked down trees and power lines in the south and southwest Twin Cities metro area. As of 2:30 p.m. EDT today, 458 Xcel customers remained without power.

Duke Energy reported more than 24,000 customers in Ohio lost power Monday morning due to an issue with the Oakley neighborhood substation. Officials said a transformer inside the substation was having current issues and shut-off automatically. As of 3:30 p.m. EDT today, 15,686 customers remained without power.
