### Update: Over 8,000 HELCO Customers in Hawaii Remain Without Power August 11 after Tropical Storm Iselle Hit August 7–8

Tropical Storm Iselle, with winds up to 70 mph, hit Hawaii Thursday night knocking out power to over 25,000 Hawaii Electric Light Co. (HELCO) customers. On Sunday, about 8,100 customers remained without power and crews had made significant progress repairing the main transmission lines that serve as the backbone of the island's electric grid, according to HELCO. Customers who were still without power should expect an extended outage into this week and, in some cases, much longer, according to HELCO.

### Excelerate Energy's Aguirre Offshore GasPort Project off Puerto Rico Receives Draft EIS from FERC

Excelerate Energy, in cooperation with the Puerto Rico Electric Power Authority (PREPA), on August 7 received the Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) for its Aguirre Offshore Gasport Project (AOGP) located offshore Puerto Rico. The FERC staff concludes in its statement that the construction and operation of the project would result in limited adverse environmental impacts that would mostly occur only during construction. FERC has opened the project for public comment until September 29. The Commission expects to issue the final EIS by December 19, 2014. Pending FERC's approval, the facility is expected to begin construction in April of 2015.
