Fire-fighting Helicopter Hits Transmission Line, Cuts Power to about 33,000 PG&E Customers in California August 27—Wildfire Burns 5,000 Acres by August 28

A helicopter struck a transmission line as it fought wildfires in Monterey, California, cutting power to about 33,000 Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) customers on August 27, a news source said. The wildfire continued to burn, but the utility restored service to nearly all affected customers by this morning, based on multiple sources. The fire began at approximately 3 PM on August 27, and had burned across 5,000 acres by August 28, a news source said. It was only 15 percent controlled, as of this morning. Officials said agricultural fireworks-devices used to keep birds away from crops—were to blame for the blaze. Governor Schwarzenegger declared a state of emergency for Monterey County today.

Luminant Plans Restart of 593 MW Monticello Coal-fired Unit 2 in Texas August 27-28

Luminant planned to restart its 593 MW Monticello coal-fired unit 2 in Texas from August 27-28, it said in a filing with state regulators. The unit tripped offline "due to a loss of a 480-Volt power control system fuse in the power center" on August 27, the company said in a separate filing.

Marathon Closes Alkylation Unit due to Leak at 76,000 b/d Texas City, Texas Refinery August 27

A leak burned one worker and forced Marathon to shut an alkylation unit at its 76,000 b/d Texas City, Texas refinery on August 27, a spokeswoman said. The company began returning the unit to service by today, according to the spokeswoman. The incident lasted less than an hour and did not impact refinery operations, she said. Update: Chevron Returns 245,271 b/d Richmond, California Refinery to Normal Operations by August 27

Chevron completed repairs to an unspecified unit and returned its 245,271 b/d Richmond, California refinery to normal operations by August 27, a company spokesman said. Trade sources identified the unit, shut since last week, as a gasoline-and-diesel-producing hydrocracker.

Enbridge Eyes November 2009 Start Date for 20-inch, Illinois-to-Alberta, Canada Southern Lights Project Oil Product Pipeline

The 20-inch line will, in conjunction with a recently-opened, southbound line, deliver a refinery product called "diluent" northbound, from Illinois to Alberta, Canada. Enbridge will, according to plan, transport Canadian crude to Illinois along its now-opened, 42-inch, 400,000 b/d Lakehead oil pipeline. Those refineries will, in turn, process the oil and ship the resulting "diluent" back to Canada. There, Enbridge will blend the product with heavy, oil-sands crude for delivery down to Illinois. Without the diluent, or some form of refining, the oil-sands crude would be undeliverable via pipeline.

Denbury Resources Plans 800 MMcf/d, 24-inch, 320-mile CO2 Pipeline in Texas

Denbury Resources plans to deliver as much as 800 million cubic feet per day (MMcf/d) of carbon dioxide (CO2) 320 miles, from Donaldsonville to the Hastings oilfield in Texas, a news source said. The company expects to inject the CO2 into aging oil deposits to help extract otherwise un-recoverable reserves. The CO2 could, according to plans, be kept underground indefinitely. Denbury plans to open the line's first phase by late 2009, and its second segment in 2010.
