PSE&G's 1,096 MW Salem Nuclear Unit 1 in New Jersey Reduced to 55 Percent by October 20

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission reported that on the morning of October 19 the unit was operating at full power.

The unit shut automatically "due to 4 kV group bus under voltage," the company said in a previous filing with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). The NRC reported that on the morning of October 19 the unit was operating at 2 percent.

Enbridge shut its 240,000 b/d, 30-inch, 524-mile, Montreal, Quebec-to-Sarnia, Ontario Line 9 on October 15-17, the company said in an October 18 bulletin. It was not clear why the line shut. It delivers condensates and sweet, light, and high-sour crude, according to the company's website.

Feldman is the same judge who tossed out the government's original six-month moratorium on deepwater drilling.

Valero fixed a leak in a butamer unit at its 142,000 b/d Corpus Christi, Texas refinery, but the incident did not affect production, according to a regulatory filing and a company spokesman.

Coffeyville Resources to Shut Unit at 115,700 b/d Coffeyville, Kansas Refinery October 19

Coffeyville Resources planned to shut an unidentified unit for repairs at its 115,700 b/d Coffeyville, Kansas refinery on October 19, the company said in a regulatory filing. The company said a malfunction had led to flaring, but it was unclear if the incident had any impact on production.

Update: Strikes Continue to Block Ports, Refineries, and Fuel Depots, Triggering Shortages at Service Stations across France October 20

Striking workers continued to block access to oil refineries, fuel depots, and the Fos Lavera and Marseilles ports on October 20, leading to fuel shortages and outages at numerous oil refineries, multiple sources reported. Of France's 12,311 filling stations, some 3,190 had run out of fuel by October 20, the nation's Ecology and Energy Minister said. An additional 1,700 stations were short on gasoline or diesel, he said. The French government, however, said separately that the nation was not short on fuel; instead, it said logistical issues were disrupting shipments to service stations. The strikes had forced offline an estimated 1.5 million b/d of refining capacity, and strikers were blocking some 69 ships – including 51 carrying crude oil or petroleum products – from docking at the Fos-Lavera and Marseilles ports, as of latest reports.

Apache Halts Output at Van Gogh Oilfield Offshore Australia by October 19

Apache stopped production at its Van Gogh field offshore Australia for unplanned work by October 19, the company said. It was not clear how much the field was producing at the time of the incident; it is expected to eventually yield 40,000 b/d. The company could resume exports by the end of December or early in January, according to one source familiar with the issue. Citing "Unsustainably Low" Natural Gas Prices, Encana Reduces Production Guidance for 2010

Encana Corporation reduced its production guidance for 2010, saying that an "oversupply of natural gas production" had led to "unsustainably low" near-time price levels. Encana said previously that it expected to increase production by 15 percent, compared to 2009. Now, the company plans to raise output by just 12 percent to a total 3.315 Bcfe/d. "The cuts are largely in the Haynesville" shale region, according to one analyst.
