Nor'Easter Knocks Out Power to Over 72,000 Customers in Northeast October 22–23

A Nor'easter producing high winds and heavy rain impacted New York, Connecticut, Rhode Island, Massachusetts, and Maine Wednesday night knocking out power to 72,939 customers. Wind gust of 50-60 mph were reported in southern Rhode Island and Massachusetts. As of 3:30 p.m. EDT today, 13,885 customers remained without power.

Illinois Approves ComEd's 345 kV Grand Prairie Gateway Transmission Line Project

The Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC) on Wednesday announced it approved ComEd's Grand Prairie Gateway Project, a new transmission line that will extend for 60 miles across Ogle, Dekalb, Kane, and DuPage Counties. The new line will create immediate customer savings by reducing grid congestion, increasing customers' access to lower-cost generation, including wind power. Construction was scheduled to begin in the second quarter of next year and the line was expected to be in service in 2017. The line will expand ComEd customers' access to generation by approximately 1,000 MW, providing greater access to clean energy. Update: Sunoco's 280,000 b/d Mid-Valley Crude Oil Pipeline to Restart Next Week; Husky's 155,000 b/d Lima, Ohio Refinery Will Boost Crude Runs

Sunoco said its Mid-Valley crude oil pipeline from Texas to Michigan is expected to resume operations next week, a move that should allow Husky Energy's Lima, Ohio refinery to boost crude runs. On Thursday, Husky Energy Inc said its plant in Lima, Ohio, has been running at reduced rates of about 110,000 b/d since October 16 because of unplanned interruptions on third-party feedstock pipelines. Husky did not identify the pipelines involved. However, the refinery receives some of its crude through the Mid-Valley pipeline operated by Sunoco Logistics Partners, a section of which has been shut since last week because of a spill in Caddo Parish, Louisiana. Later on Thursday, Sunoco told shippers in a notice that it expects to return the affected segment of the pipeline – which runs from Longview, Texas, to Samaria, Michigan, and passes through Lima – to service the week of October 27. The company said it is progressing in the repair and retesting of the pipeline returns to service, the Lima plant will still face supply issues. On a conference call on Thursday, Husky executives said that "ongoing curtailment" on Mid-Valley could impact up to 15,000 b/d of refinery throughput into 2015. U.S. Threatens to Impose Sanctions on Buyers of Islamic State Oil

The Obama administration on Thursday threatened to impose sanctions on anyone buying oil from Islamic State (IS) militants in an effort to disrupt what it said was a \$1 million a day funding source. IS has seized large swaths of Iraq and Syria in a brutal campaign, and could pose a threat to the U.S. and its allies if it is not stopped, U.S. Treasury Undersecretary David Cohen said. IS is generating tens of millions of dollars a month through a combination of oil sales, ransom, extortion and other criminal activities and support from wealthy donors, Cohen said in laying out the most comprehensive outline yet of the U.S. financial strategy against the group. Oil in particular is a key funding source, he said. IS has tapped into the black market in oil in Syria and Iraq, refining some and selling it to smugglers who transport it to Turkey and the Kurdish region of Iraq. Cohen, the Obama administration's point man on sanctions, said the Syrian government, which has been fighting a long civil war against opposition forces, has also apparently agreed to buy oil from IS. He said some recent air strikes by the U.S. and others have destroyed some refineries controlled by IS, disrupting its oil revenue, but it was still important to find other ways to target the group's funding sources and prevent access to the formal financial system.
