Luminant expected to shut the unit "to repair a boiler tube leak" from November 23-24, according to a filing with state regulators.

Update: Luminant to Restart 793 MW Martin Lake Coal-fired Unit 3 in Texas November 24-25

The unit shut due to "the malfunction of the boiler water circulation pump" on November 23, Luminant said in a previous filing. Operators had been returning the unit from a separate outage, at the time of the incident, according to the filing.

FirstEnergy Declares Unusual Event at 923 MW Beaver Valley Nuke Unit 2 in Pennsylvania November 24

FirstEnergy declared an unusual event due to a leak in the reactor coolant system of its 923 MW Beaver Valley nuke unit 2 in Pennsylvania, the company said in a filing with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on November 24. Operators stopped the leak, and the company said the incident did not cause any radioactive releases. FirstEnergy Plans 268 MW Compressed Air Power Plant in Ohio

FirstEnergy plans to construct a 268 MW compressed air-based power plant in Norton, Ohio, and could eventually expand the site to generate as much as 2,700 MW of electricity, according to a company release. The facility, or "Norton Energy Storage Project," would compress air in an underground cavern during off-peak hours, and then release the air to generate power at times of higher electric demand. Its initial phase would involve two to four power units, and produce at least 268 MW of electricity.

PPL Electric Utilities Plans 69-kV, 11-to-12-Mile Electric Transmission Line in Pennsylvania

PPL Electric Utilities expects to construct a 69-kV, 11-to-12-mile electric transmission line and associated substation in Susquehanna Valley, Pennsylvania, the company said in a release. The line would connect two existing lines, though PPL Electric Utilities has not finalized the project's route. The company expects to break ground in the summer of 2011 and open the project in the fall of 2012.

Husky Energy Reports Fire and Oil Spill at 146,200 b/d Lima, Ohio Refinery November 22—Incidents Occurred as Company Returned Facility from Planned Outage

A fire damaged an iso-cracker unit at Husky Energy's 146,200 b/d Lima, Ohio refinery on November 22, but operators continued to restart the facility—minus the affected iso-cracker—after more than one month of planned maintenance, multiple news sources reported on November 23-24. Separately at Lima, an oil tank "boiled over... splitting open the top" of a fixed roof tank and spilling an estimated 49,000 gallons of oil. That incident also occurred in November 22, but was not related to the fire. The company did not expect the spill to postpone its start-up plans.

Bomb Attack Forces Shut 500,000 b/d Iraq-to-Turkey Oil Pipeline by November 21 A bomb attack forced shut the approximately 500,000 b/d Kirkuk, Iraq-to-Ceyhan, Turkey by November 21, and operators expected repair-work to stretch until as late as November 28, an Iraqi Oil Ministry official and news sources said. The assault occurred in Salahuddin province, Iraq. One vessel was waiting to load oil at the line's terminus, in Turkey, on November 24; the terminal had 1.9 million barrels of crude in storage, according to a news source.

Update: Spectra Energy Launches Open Season for Planned 500 MMcf/d Expansion along Gulf Coast-to-U.S. Northeast Natural Gas Pipeline System November 23-January 15

Spectra Energy launched a binding open season for a proposed 500 MMcf/d expansion along its Gulf Čoast-to-U.S. Northeast Texas Eastern Transmission natural gas pipeline system, the company said in a November 23 release. The project, or "TEAM 2013," would deliver natural gas from Appalachia and the Marcellus Shale to the U.S. Northeast. It would enter service in late 2013, according to company estimates.
