Electricity

Update: 362,000 Customers from Michigan to Maine Remain Without Power After Ice, Snow Storm

Approximately 362,000 customers remained without power Tuesday after a snow and ice storm moved across Michigan, New York, and northern New England over the past few days. In Michigan, the hardest hit state, 242,600 customers remained without power despite around the clock repairs by line workers. As of 12:30 p.m. EST, Consumers Energy reported 174,000 customers remained without electricity in the mid and western portions of the state, out of 303,000 affected customers. In the Metro Detroit area, DTE Energy reported 55,000 customers remained without power, out of 150,000 that have been affected by the storm. The Lansing Board of Water & Light reported Tuesday morning that 13,600 remained without electricity. According to a DTE spokesperson, crews will continue to work through Christmas Eve and Christmas Day until power is fully restored. DTE has brought in 450 linemen from other states including West Virginia, Pennsylvania, Georgia, Indiana, Illinois, and Ohio.

Update: Over 238,000 Customers in Ontario and Quebec Remain Without Power After Ice Storm

About 238,000 customers in Ontario and Quebec remained without power after an ice storm moved across the provinces December 21–23. As of 12:30 p.m., Toronto Hydro reported approximately 90,000 customers remain without power, down from 300,000 at the height of the storm. About 31,500 Hydro-Quebec customers were without power on Monday, down from 198,500 customers. Hydro One reported 59,471 customers remained without power down from 120,000 customers. PowerStream, Veridian Connections, and New Brunswick Power reported 6,400, 7,000, and 43,932 customers respectively without power.

Hawaiian Electric's 5 MW Kalaeloa Renewable Energy Park Comes Online December 23

Kalaeloa Renewable Energy Park opened today and will immediately begin generating electricity for Hawaiian Electric customers on Oahu. Following four years of development and construction, the 5MW, utility-scale solar park was successfully tested and commissioned on November 22. The renewable power plant is expected to reduce the fossil fuel consumption on the island. The facility is comprised of 21,000 photovoltaic panels and will generate around 9 million kWh of electricity per year.

Marathon's 114,000 b/d Detroit, Michigan Refinery to Reach Full Rates After Unit Restart

Marathon Petroleum's Detroit refinery is expected to reach full rates after completing the restart of a diesel hydrotreater, according to a person familiar with operations. The unit was started December 20 after shutting the previous day when a gasket blew out on a check valve. Repairs were completed and the unit was expected to ramp up to 100 percent capacity by the end of the day, the person said.

Enbridge Reports AGIs Trip at Its Tilden Gas Plant in Texas December 23

Enbridge reported that due to the chiller tripping on low cooling water temperature, acid gas injectors (AGIs) no. 1 and 2 tripped on fifth stage high discharge pressure. Plant personnel determined that the chiller needed to have the temperature reset from 60 to 65 degrees. Once the chiller was operating normally, the AGIs were restarted and stabilized.

South Sudan's Oil Output Falls 45,000 b/d Due to Rebel Fighting – Petroleum Minister

South Sudan's oil production fell by 45,000 b/d to 200,000 b/d after oilfields in Unity state shut down due to rebel fighting, the petroleum minister told Reuters on Tuesday.
