

ESF-12 Situation Report

August 19, 2004 2200

- In Florida approximately 86 percent of the customers have had power restored. Currently, 248,316 remain without power. Some utilities report that restoration in hard hit counties could take the remainder of the month.
- The Atlanta Regional Operations Center (ROC) will deactivate as of 2400 August 20, 2004. ESF-12 Staff will remain in the ROC through 08/19/2004. The ESF-12 position at the DFO in Orlando is currently staffed by two Office of Energy Assurance personnel.
