U.S. West Coast Gasoline Prices Rise at Record Pace on Refinery Outages

Retail prices for regular gasoline in West Coast states rose a record 37.2 cents a gallon since last week to \$3.12 a gallon on Monday, the U.S. Energy Information Administration (EIA) said. The increase marks the largest week-toweek increase in the region since the EIA's weekly survey of West Coast prices began in 1992. California, which relies heavily on in-state production to meet its large demand for fuels, has seen its output hampered by an explosion and fire at ExxonMobil Corp's 149,500 b/d refinery in Torrance, California, on February 18. Units unaffected by the blast are operating. In the San Francisco area, Tesoro Corp's 166,000 b/d Golden Eagle refinery in Martinez stopped producing gasoline last month amid a labor strike. The company last week said the refinery had resumed turnaround work and was making plans to restart the plant.

Shell Announces Plan to Replace USW Workers at Its 327,000 b/d Deer Park, Texas **Refinery by Mid-Summer**

Royal Dutch Shell on Monday announced plans to train and deploy enough "relief workers" by mid-summer to keep its Deer Park refinery running at full operations without union labor. United Steelworkers (USW) members went on strike at the complex on February 1 after their contract expired and talks broke down. The announcement comes amid a national strike that's now widened to 12 refineries accounting for almost 20 percent of the refining capacity in the U.S. Shell said on Monday that the company had been preparing staff to replace union workers since the walkout began. After putting in place non-union Shell employees to run operations at the plant, the company turned its focus to bringing in and training additional staff, the company said.

BP Continues Work to Restart CDU at Its 413,500 b/d Whiting, Indiana Refinery March 1 – Sources

Work was continuing on Sunday to restart the 110,000 b/d crude distillation unit (CDU) at BP's Whiting, Indiana, refinery, said sources familiar with plant operations. The CDU, which is the second largest crude unit at the refinery was shut on February 25 by a malfunction. Since then the refinery has worked to return the CDU to production. The repairs were expected to take a few days, sources familiar with plant operations said on Thursday. The other two CDUs at the refinery have remained in operation while the 110,000 b/d unit has been shut. BP Whiting is one of the 12 U.S. refineries on strike.
