Major Developments

Update: BP Develops Plans for New Containment Cap for Gulf of Mexico

The National Incident Commander has approved a plan for BP to replace the existing lower marine riser package (LMRP) containment cap with a new sealing cap assembly. The new sealing cap contains multiple ports for connection to additional containment options, which should increase oil and gas collection to 53,000 b/d initially, when the Helix producer is attached. BP hopes to be able to increase collection to 60,000 to 80,000 b/d by the end of July. BP removed the LMRP cap on July 10 and began work on installing the new cap, which is expected to take 4-7 days. On July 10, a total of about of 15,200 barrels of oil were collected or flared and 35.2 MMcf of gas were flared according to the company website. No oil was collected on July 11 and none will be for several days, until the new containment cap is attached.

Update: Taiwanese Supertanker "A Whale" Skimming Oily Water from Gulf of Mexico

Additional skimmers have surged to the site of the blown-out well due to calmer seas and because the LMRP cap was removed on Saturday (resulting in a higher rate of oil gushing into the Gulf). Department of Interior Issues New Moratorium for Deepwater Oil and Gas Projects

The new ban issued on July 12 is effective through November 30 or until Interior Secretary Salazar determines that deepwater drilling operations can proceed safely. A previous six-month ban, issued after the Deepwater Horizon well blew in April, was thrown out by a federal judge.
