Abengoa announced yesterday that it has finalized a loan guarantee with the U.S. Department of Energy to build the Mojave Solar Project near Barstow, California. Construction is underway at the 280 MW concentrating solar power plant, which is expected to come online in 2014. Pacific Gas & Electric will buy electricity from the plant under the terms of a 25-year power purchase agreement.
