### Typhoon Champi Leaves Island-Wide Blackout on Saipan October 16

The Commonwealth Utilities Corporation (CUC) reported the last of Saipan's distribution feeders went offline at 2:07 p.m. ChST (12:07 am EDT) on Friday, leaving an island-wide blackout for all 14,662 electric customers in wake of Typhoon Champi. The temporary repairs from Typhoon Soudelor at Power Plants Nos. 1 and 4 withstood the worst of the storm, and all generators remain fully operational. As of 4:00 p.m. ChST (2:00 am EDT), the CUC reported a total of nine downed power poles, but wind speeds were too high for its crews to address all restoration issues. The utility said once unsafe weather conditions pass, repair crews will begin work on Feeder 1 to restore service to the island's hospital.

## Valero to Shut Crude, Gasoline Units at Its 180,000 b/d Memphis, Tennessee Refinery – Sources

Valero Energy Corp was preparing on Thursday to shut the smaller crude distillation unit (CDU) and the main gasoline-producing unit at its Memphis, Tennessee refinery, said sources familiar with the company's plans. Valero will attach a flue gas cooler to the 65,000 b/d fluidic catalytic cracking unit (FCCU), which will take about three weeks to complete, the sources said. An increase in leakage from the FCCU required the flue gas cooler be installed this fall rather than next year, the sources said. Work will also be done on a sulfur recovery unit while the FCCU and West CDU are shut. A 110,000 b/d CDU will remain in operation at the refinery while the smaller unit is shut. ### Occidental Petroleum Agrees to Sell Its Oil Acreage to Lime Rock Resources in North Dakota – Sources

Occidental Petroleum Corp agreed to sell all of its North Dakota shale oil acreage and assets to private equity fund Lime Rock Resources in a deal worth around \$500 million, according to sources familiar with the matter. The sale encompasses all of Oxy's more than 300,000 acres in the state, including a 21,000 square-foot regional office built just three years ago.
